COMMENTARY ON ANNUAL ACCOUNTS TO 31 DECEMBER 2019

The accounts show an operating deficit for the year of £1,813 as compared to a £1,876 surplus for the previous year.

Total income at £44,942 is some £1,800 less than last year. The principal reasons being a drop in our investment income as forecast at last year's Annual Meeting and reduced income from membership dues. Total expenditure for the year at £46,755 shows an increase of around £1,850 compared to the previous year. Savings on office expenses have been offset by increased expenditure on the Annual Meeting. After being at the University for so many years we had to move because of unavailability and the result has been a significant increase in costs, in excess of budget, for the year. Steps are in hand to find a new location for 2021 which have to take into account that the venue at Droitwich is no longer operating and the university has announced large increases in its room hire and catering costs.

Provincial Grand Lodge faces the same difficulties and uncertainties as other organisations in these CV-19 times but taking into account its foreseeable income and revenue commitments, as well as the uncertainties we face as individual members, I do not propose any change in annual dues at this stage.

In conclusion I would like to thank the staff and volunteers at Provincial Grand office for their assistance throughout the year. I would also like to thank Lodge Treasurers and Secretaries who give freely of their time and support Province by the timely remittance of Returns and Funds.

It contains amongst other items, the latest on our exit from suspension repeated in part below.

- 1. As soon as government guidance changes to allow groups of ten or more people from different households to meet indoors, it is expected that a lifting of the suspension of Masonic activity will be announced. The resumption of meetings will take place fourteen days after the announcement or on the date, if later, on which the government guidance becomes effective.
- 2. Lodges and Chapters will be permitted to meet with no more present than the government's prescribed maximum.
- 3. It is likely that shielding policies for vulnerable members will remain in force, and such members are strongly advised to follow the advice of their doctors and not attend until it is felt safe for them to do so.
